A selection of up to 10 enthusiastic volunteers will be selected to work together providing a range of activities, events and pastoral support for students remaining on campus as a result of Covid-19.


THE ROLE

Once formal training has been completed, volunteers will be expected to:

- Plan, lead and deliver the range of activities for the period of the winter break
- Support the general operations of the College and the activities of the students
- Support the ideals and ethos of the UWC movement

NEED TO KNOW

- Suited candidates will ideally be aged 21-25
- All volunteers will need to arrive at UWC Atlantic on or shortly before Sunday 28th November 2021 and remain with us until at least Wednesday 5th January 2022
- Assistance with transport can be provided from local travel stations (e.g. Cardiff, Bridgend) upon request
- All volunteers will receive full board and lodging on campus

- We can only accept applications from those who do not require a visa and/or have no legal requirement to quarantine on arrival at UWC Atlantic Applications will need to undertake a full DBS check prior to commencing the volunteer programme. You must submit the supporting documents as part of the application process
Applications must be submitted by 12th November and available for a video interview during the week of the 14th November
 - Formal offers will then be made on Friday 19th November so it is essential that you only apply if you are able to make these deadlines
 - All applicants must agree to the UWC Volunteer Code of Conduct as well as the Volunteer Role Expectations
